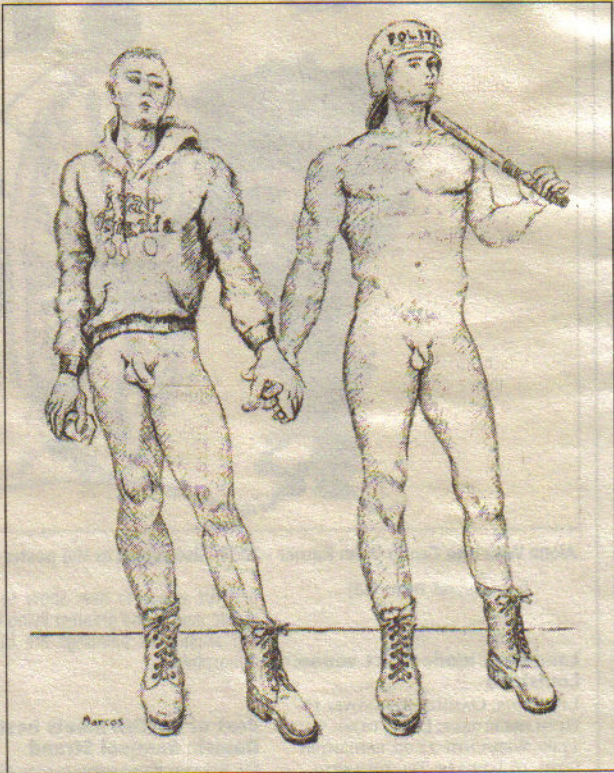

entrance to the Spiselloppen restaurant, is the "official" art space of Christiania, which has called itself "Stadens Museum for Kunst" (Staden = slang for Christiania), as a gimmick of the National Gallery (which, in Danish, is called "Statens Museum for Kunst"). The Danish-based American artist Marcos Byrd is the featured artist of the month - very typical of the kind of art one can find at Galloperiet: sometimes alternative, often self-taught, and always with a somehow messy, free spirit vibe to it - characteristic of the loose living style of Christiania.

Marcos Byrd is one of the important fresco painters in Denmark, living mainly of large-scale decorations on large walls, in cultural institutions, the

Copenhagen Zoo and outdoor buildings. With a distinctive colourful style and with a close relationship to nature, animals and humans, Marcos Byrd shows new works at Galloperiet throughout January.
