January 15, -Saturday at 20:00 Marcos will perform some of his “byrd” songs. Entrance gratis.

The American expatriate, Marcos Byrd, known for his whale motifs in Copenhagen's Natural Museum and The Hans Christian Andersen Mural in Køge, exhibits new and old works at Gallopperiet, Stadens Museum for Kunst, Christiania.

The paintings are divided into categories: The Everyday, The Political, The Sexual, The Decorative and The Esoteric. Common with these thematic paintings is a poignant sense of drama. Questioned about this Byrd replies: “ Well, it's art ain't it? I hope the critics grant me that. All art is an abstraction of life and life is a journey full of diverse distractions and adventures. At least, it should be. I'm lucky to have had a full life. And that's what I reflect.”
