Inspiration (in general): Along the lines of drama, eroticism, dreams, allegory and anything I personally consider beautiful, even if it's conventionally ugly.

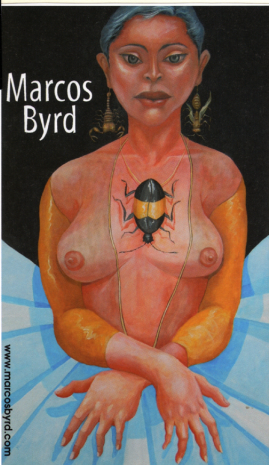
